SUBJECT: Training

Welcome to the Virtual United States Air Force! Your first task to becoming a vUSAF Pilot is to complete Pilot Training; in order to begin your virtual career in your selected Airframe. Your first assignment is to complete the Air Education & Training Command's Pilot Training Program. This program is comprised of several self-help modules that you, the new member will be required to complete. You will be assigned to the 47th Flying Training Wing – KDLF - where you will conduct your flight training.

You will record your Flights with FS Recorder, after completing the module, and then email the results to instructors@vusaf.us for evaluation. Please download FSR and FSR Setup instruction from the AETC Training Center. You are required to complete at a minimum one (1) module every seven (7) days, failure to do so shall result in being dropped from the program for inactivity. If you require assistance with a module contact an Instructor Pilot at instructors@vusaf.us for assistance. If you require a leave of absence, contact the AETC Commander.

For your anticipated career track, the following modules will be assigned to you, they are available in the AETC Training Center: IFS Flight Training – IFT Flight Training - VATSIM/FSInn exam, UPT Flight Training - SUPT Flight Training – MQT Flight Training.

Fighter career track, you have a total of ten (10) weeks to complete PTP, Bomber career track, you have a total of eight (8) weeks to complete PTP, otherwise you may be subject to discharge. **Your first Flight will be the - Initial Flight Placement Exam - IFS-100 - This flight is a mandatory flight for all new recruits coming into vUSAF. This exam will allow our IP's in AETC, to determine which course is best for you, based on your flight experience. Those of you with a lot of experience may be fast tracked depending on the results from your flight. Make sure to follow the directions for this Flight, and when completed, send a copy of your FSR file to instructors@vusaf.us**

A staff member from AETC will assign you each mission and Exam in sequence, you may find your pending assignment under – Air Education Training Command - AETC MISSION SCHEDULE - under your name and vUSAF I.D. Once you complete a module, you will need to file a Mission Report in the main secure area of the web site in addition to emailing your files as indicated in the module instructions, failure to do so may result in not receiving credit and possibly being dropped from the program. Please remember to include the mission assignment number in your report; it is a unique ID that is on the schedule page for your specific assignment.

To begin the Pilot Training Program point your browser to <http://www.vusaf.org>, select vUSAF Secure Area and log in with your vUSAF PIN as your username, and your vUSAF Password, which was provided to you in a separate email. If you did not receive these login details, please contact Robert Phillips at rtpillips@vusaf.org. Once you are logged in, review the entire contents of the page.
